Notes of Committee Meeting No 10 held at Market Harborough on Sunday 20 February 2000 5.30pm to 6.00pm

1. PURPOSE OF MEETING

The Chairman explained that he had called the meeting to discuss the irregularities which had occurred at the Jumping Jacks' sanctioned show held on Sunday 13th February 2000. He briefly outlined these irregularities and advised that a letter of complaint had been received from the captain of the Maple Leafs.

2. DISCUSSION

The Committee agreed that there was definitely a case to answer and that the new rules and policies had been issued in time for them to be implemented at this show.

It was therefore agreed that a letter should be sent to the captain of the Jumping Jacks advising that all future sanctioned shows must comply with current BFA rules and policies and that, in accordance with these rules, the Committee would instruct the Stats Officer to ensure that the records show that the winner of the competition would be the top BFA team on the day.

3. ACTIONS

The Committee agreed the wording of the letter to be sent to the captain of the Jumping Jacks and the Secretary agreed to raise this letter as soon as possible, sending two copies – one by recorded delivery and one by first class post (with proof of posting).

Since this concluded the business for the day at the meeting closed at 6.00pm.
