- 1. Minutes of last meeting (No 03-2012/13) Confirm as a true record of proceedings
- 2. Chairs Opening Address The Chair thanked all of the committee for the time they give to the work on behalf of the BFA. Good sportsmanship and dog welfare continue to be at the heart of all we do and following the well-received reports at the AGM, the chair suggested continuance of these messages via the BFA official announcements and the associations publication; the Flyball Record.

3. Matters arising: Working Party Updates

- Website Working Party work continues to utilise the skills and expertise within the working party whilst at the same time ensuring all the specific requirements are captured to form a solid foundation to go to tender for the future site and supporting database. The committee requested more regular updates from the working party and early sign off of the documents for tender.
- Lights Working Party work to define the exact scope of the lights build continues. The lights working party will document the specification to inform the Abtec order.
- Measuring Devise Working Party Following the recent rule change at the 2013 AGM, the laser measuring devices have been issued out to accompany the light sets; both BFA and private. Reports to the committee showed that the measuring stick has proven to be heavier than expected and, despite being white, not as reflective of the laser beam. A decision was made by the committee to seek replacements.

The Treasurer is investigating the acceptance of receiving online payments from Tournament Organisers for entries, lights hire, etc. Outputs from these investigations will be discussed in more detail at future meetings to arrive at decisions to further streamline payment and receipt processes.

Officials to provide the Administration, the Awards & Trophies Coordinator and the Camping Co-ordinator were agreed.

It was decided that a charge would be made for trade stands again this year. BFA member stands will be charged £50 for the weekend and Non BFA member stands will be charged £150 for the weekend, rescues will be allowed a stand free of charge, with approval from the committee.

Sponsorship for the BFA's flagship event are being considered. Volunteers from the membership will be requested nearer the time to assist with directing arrivals to the assigned camping pitches.

Team entry fees will be £35 per team and camping will be charged at a flat rate of £20 for Thurs, Fri, Sat and Sunday nights.

A photographer has been arranged and other providers are being sourced. The St John's Ambulance will be on site as in previous years. A tournament information pack will be produced. More details will follow.
