

Show Rules and Regulations

1. The events organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing with the B.F.A.
2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
4. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - a. Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases.
 - b. A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
 - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
5. It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the team is available in their class and running order.
6. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances
7. All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to a dog's, persons or property whilst at the event.
8. All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
9. B.F.A. rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
10. If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the tournament, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received
