

- The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- O All owners and handlers enter their dogs at their and their pets own risk and whilst every care is taken, the event organiser(s) will not accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs persons or property whilst at the event.
- All dog owners/handlers must clean up after their dog(s). Anyone failing to do so, will be asked to leave the venue.
- o BFA rulesand policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
- All teams entering the show are expected to assist with ring party duties as required by the event organiser(s).
- O Dogs must be kept under control at all times whilst attending the event.
