
Camping available on site from Friday night.

Directions to the Venue

From Junction 17 of the M4 Motorway take the B4122, at the next junction turn left on to the B4069 towards Sutton Benger. In Sutton Benger turn left in front of the Church which is opposite 'The Bell' Hotel. Take this country route for about 4 miles, go through the village of Great Somerford and the Show Ground is on the left hand side just over the river as you leave the village.

From Swindon and M4 Junction 16 take the Wootton Bassett road and at the second roundabout take the B4042 signposted for Brinkworth and Malmesbury; follow the signs for the Somerfords, once you get to Little Somerford proceed to Great Somerford and after $\frac{3}{4}$ mile the Show Ground will be on your right just before the river.



Warning: The River Avon runs alongside the site; any dogs swimming in it are doing so at the risk of the owner. The tournament organisers will not hold liability in the event of any injury, illness to or loss of the dog.

Show Rules and Regulations

- 1) The Event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
- 2) No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- 3) Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed at the event.
- 4) A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - a) Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases;
 - b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal; or
 - c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- 5) It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for their division and running order.
- 6) No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- 7) The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 8) All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Event Organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 9) No alcohol can be consumed within the ring.
- 10) All owners/handlers **must** clean up after their dog; anyone failing to do so **will** be asked to leave the venue.
- 11) If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
- 12) On and around the venue a strict speed limit (10 mph/16kph) will apply throughout the event.
- 13) BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.

Note: In the event of a tie between more than 2 teams fastest times will decide final placings.
