SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) The Event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA or with Saltires Flyball Teams.
- 2) No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- 3) Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 4) A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - a) Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases;
 - b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal; or
 - c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- 5) It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for their class and running order.
- 6) No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- 7) The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 8) All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Event Organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 9) No alcohol can be consumed within or around the ring.
- 10) All owners/handlers must clean up after their dog. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 11) If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
- 12) On and around the Showground a strict speed limit (5 mph) will apply and vehicle movement restrictions will apply throughout the event.
- 13) BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.

Directions to Royal Highland Centre, Ingliston, Edinburgh, EH28 8NB

From all directions follow signs for Edinburgh airport, this will bring you to the venue via the A8, the old Edinburgh to Glasgow road.

As you leave the A8 / Airport Roundabout, follow Eastfield Road straight over one roundabout.

Turn left at the next roundabout onto Fairview Road.

Stay on Fairview Road until you reach a T Junction. Turn right onto Ingliston Road.

At the roundabout, turn left in at gate 6 and seek instructions for parking or camping.
