- 4. A dog must be withdrawn from the competition if it is:
 - a. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease.
 - b. A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
 - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- 5. It is the team captains responsibility to ensure that the team is available for their class and running order.
- 6. No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- 7. The organiser reserves the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 8. All dogs are entered in this event at their owners risk and, whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 9.All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs anywhere in the grounds. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 10.If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the tournament, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.
