Show Rules and Regulations

For Ryecroft Farm

- 1. The tournament organiser (s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any person not in good standing with the B.F.A.
- 2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at a tournament.
- 3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 4. A dog must be withdrawn from the tournament if it is :
 - a. Suffering from an infectious or contagious disease
 - b. A danger to the safety of any person or animal
 - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
- 5. It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for its class and running order
- 6. The organiser (s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 7. All dogs enter into the tournament at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 8. All owners / handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 8. B.F.A rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
- 9. A STRICT SPEED LIMIT OF 10mph IS IN FORCE ON THE DRIVE TO THE FARM AND WALKING PACE ON THE FIELD. ANYONE SPEEDING WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE VENUE.
- 10. The farmyard is OUT OF BOUNDS to all flyballers, adults AND CHILDREN. This is for safety reasons. ANY PERSONS ENTERING THE YARD WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE VENUE.
- 11. No alcohol is to be consumed within or around the ring.
- 12. NO BARBECUES TO BE USED DIRECTLY ON THE GRASS

DIRECTIONS TO RYECROFT FARM, ASHLEY MILL LANE, ASHLEY, CHESHIRE. WA14 3PX

- 1. From Junction 19 on M6, take A556 in direction of Altrincham / Manchester. At the second lights turn right by the Swan hotel. (The A556 can be a very busy road making it difficult to turn right, especially if towing a caravan. An alternative to turning right is to go to the next roundabout and return along the A556) (Go to 3)
- From the M56 take the A556 in the direction of M6/Northwich. At first set of light turn left at Swan Hotel. (Go to 3)
- 3 At approximately one mile, turn left just past garage, signposted Tatton Park.Go past the main entrance to Tatton Park, continue through some bends until the crossroads with a pub on the left (the Greyhound) and garage on the right. At the crossroads, turn left, go under the motorway and continue for just over one mile. Turn into Ashley Mill Lane on the left. After a short distance the drive to Ryecroft Farm is on the left.
