## Show Rules and Regulations

1. The event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any person(s) not in good standing within the BFA.
2. No person shall impugn the decision of the Head Judge or Judges.
3. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
4. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs at the event is not allowed.
5. a dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
  - a) suffering from infectious or contagious diseases
  - b) a danger to the safety of any person or animal
  - c) likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
6. The Team Captains/Managers are responsible for ensuring their teams are available for their class and running order.
7. Team Captains/Managers are responsible for ensuring that all members of their teams and accompanying party are informed of the rules and regulations pertaining to this tournament.
8. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
9. If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the Tournament, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.
10. All dogs/owners/handlers enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss, however caused to dogs, persons or property, whilst at the event.
11. All owners/handlers MUST clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
12. Current BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
13. Every team must ensure that ALL rubbish is removed or put in receptacles before leaving the site.
14. No alcohol to be consumed within or around the ring.



## High Flyers Entry Form
