## Show rules and regulations

1) The event organisers reserve the right to refuse entries and admission

to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA 2) BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament

3) No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges

4) It is the team captain's responsibility to ensure the team is available for their divisions and running order

5) No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament

6) Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed

7) The organisers reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances

8) A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:

a. suffering from any infectious or contagious disease

**b**. a danger to safety of any person or animal

**c**. likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete

9) All dogs are entered in this event at their owners risk and, whilst every care will be taken, the event organisers cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event

10) All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue

11) No alcohol to be consumed within or around the ring

12) In the unfortunate event of abandonment of the show through circumstances beyond the control of the organisers, expenses may be defrayed from the entry fees to cover the cost of the preparations for the show.

13) In the event of a team having to withdraw from the competition a refund will only be possible if another team is able to fill the place.

14) No loud music after 11pm.

15) Barbeques must not be placed on the grass

# **Tournament Running Order**

Lower divisions will run on Saturday and higher divisions on Sunday. It is estimated that each team will have at least 5 races in a division.



### Information

Food will be available on site catered by the RSPCA.

There will be a tombola/raffle and various stalls with all proceeds going to the Southridge veterinary fund.

Competitors are welcome to look around the centre during opening times but the RSPCA request that competitors stay away from the animal units after closing time so as not to distress the animals.

There is a public footpath running through a field adjacent to the Flyball field, the RSPCA request that for off lead exercise you use this field during their opening hours to avoid off lead dogs coming into contact with their dogs which will be exercised on lead around the centre during the day. Please respect this request as they have many resident dogs with fear/aggression issues.

### Directions

Coming clockwise on the M25:

Leave the M25 at junction 22, At roundabout take 5<sup>th</sup> exit onto the A1081 (signed Radlet, Watford, Heathrow, M25, M1, M4, South Mimms, B556). At the next roundabout take the first exit on to Ridge Hill – B556 (signposted South Mimms)

After 1.2 miles turn right in to Packhorse lane

Coming anti clockwise on the M25:

Leave the M25 at junction 22. At the roundabout take the first exit on to Ridge Hill – B556 (signposted South Mimms)

After 1.2 miles turn right in to Packhorse lane

The RSPCA centre is approximately 300 yards along on the left hand side

Packhorse lane is a single track road with regular passing places, there is usually only very light traffic on this road.
