SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The Event Organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
- 2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- 3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 4. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - a. Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases.
 - b. A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
 - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- 5. It is the Team Captain's responsibility to ensure the Team is available for their Division and running order.
- 6. The Organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 7. All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Event Organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 8. All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the Ovenue.
- 9. BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.
- 10. The Venue is within a working Racing School's private grounds and during the weekend other activities may be organised and horses will be being exercised. Public footpaths are adjacent to the Venue which should be utilised as dog exercise areas. Any dogs taken into the racing college private grounds must be kept on leads and under proper control at all times and owners MUST pick up after their dogs in all areas.

Directions to Racing College:-

From M18 J3 Follow signs for Doncaster Racecourse (brown local signs)

From M18 at first roundabout straight over. At second bear left. (Road not P&O depot) Third straight over.

(Renault garage is now on left.) Immediately after this roundabout, take right hand lane to fourth roundabout which is right turn onto A18 dual carriageway. Proceed down Dual carriageway (watch for speed camera on central carriageway). Next Roundabout is the Racecourse turn right A638 and follow Local route below.

From M18 J4 Proceed towards Doncaster IKEA W/House on Left. At the first and second roundabouts go straight over. At third (Sainsbury's) take Left A18 under bridge to the next (fourth) roundabout (Miller Bros). Straight over this one to fifth (KFC) straight over slightly left still on A18 to the sixth which is again straight over down slight a slight hill past a school on the left then the Racecourse on the left and finally in left lane to the Racecourse Roundabout at which you turn left down A638 and follow Local Route Below.

Local Route from Racecourse Roundabout.

Proceed along A638 heading toward Bawtry for approximately 4.5 miles. Continue straight over at <u>all traffic lights</u>. On the way you will go over the motorway, finally you will arrive at a set of lights which Robin Hood Airport is signposted left. **KEEP STRAIGHT ON**. You will pass Mount Pleasant Hotel on your right. The Northern Racing College is the **NEXT FILTERED** right turn. Turn in and follow the sign to St Leger Horse Park.

From A1 SOUTH (IE. heading north)

Proceed North on A1 to Blyth Roundabout. (This is where A1 changes to A1M) Take Right exit A638 signed Bawtry. Proceed through Bawtry toward Doncaster. You will pass Yorkshire Caravans on your Right. The Northern Racing College is on Your Left (you should see the white rails on the left had side of the road. Turn in the Entrance and follow the sign to St Leger Horse Park.
