Please note: Final running orders will be sent by email to team captain's approx 1 week prior to the event. Please make sure you have included your email address. Any teams requiring it by post please enclose a stamped addressed envelope. The two-minute rule will apply throughout the tournament.

Show Rules and Regulations

- 1. The tournament organisers(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any persons not in good standing with the BFA
- 2. No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- 3. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament
- 4. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 5. A dog must be withdrawn from the tournament if it is:
 - 1. Suffering from an infectious or contagious disease
 - 2. A danger to the safety of any person or animal
 - 3. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
- 6. It is the Team Captain's Responsibility to ensure the team is available for their division and running order
- 7. The organisers(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances
- 8. All dogs enter in the tournament at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the tournament organisers(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event
- 9. All owners/ handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 10. Current BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament
- 11. No alcohol to be consumed within or around the ring. No smoking within the ring.
- 12. If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the tournament, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received

Directions – NE61 5BX (postcode takes you to the Visitor centre!)

From the North

- A1 South
- At Alnwick take the exit for the A1068 toward Shilbottle/Alnwick/Alnmouth/Ashington
- Follow the A1068 past Amble and on reaching East Chevington turn left into the Country Park (there are Brown tourist signs)
- Follow the drive down (there are speed bumps) and follow the flyball signs once within the park.

From the South

- A19 north through Tyne Tunnel and continue on A19 North
- At Moor Farm Roundabout (approx 6.5 miles after tunnel) take the 5th exit onto A189 heading to Ashington / Blyth
- Follow A189 (brown signs for Coastal route)
- After approx 11.3 miles at the roundabout take the A1068
- Follow A1068, past Red Row and onto East Chevington turn right into Country Park (Brown tourist signs)
- Follow the drive down (there are speed bumps) and follow the flyball signs once within the park.
