- 1. The event organisers reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
- 2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of dog at the event
- 3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dog at the show is not permitted
- 4. A dog must be withdrawn from the competition if it is:
  - a) Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease
  - b) A danger to te safety of any person or animal.
  - c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
- 5. It is the team captain's responsibility to ensure the team is available for their class and running order.
- 6. No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- 7. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 8. All dogs are entered in this event at their owners risk and, whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 9. All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs, anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 10. If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organizers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
- 11. No dogs are allowed on the training areas of the sport centre
