### **Show Rules and Regulations**

# Current BFA Rules and Regulations will apply throughout this sanctioned tournament

- 1. The event organisers reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
- 2. No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- 3. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh treatment of a dog at the tournament or act in such a way as to bring the sport of flyball into disrepute.
- 4. All owners must clean up after their dogs or you will be asked to leave the venue immediately.
- 5. All dogs, owners/handlers enter at their own risk. Whilst at the venue every care will be taken to prevent accidents and the organisers hold no responsibility however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 6. Dogs recovering from surgery or illness and bitches in season must not be entered and must be withdrawn if a season starts during the competition. Any bitch in season must not be brought near to the competition arena. Sale of puppies is strictly forbidden.
- 7. Mating of dogs at the event is not allowed. BFA Rule:5.19
- 8. A dog must be withdrawn from competition
  - If they are suffering or become injured during the competition
  - If suffering from any type of infection or contagious diseases
  - Any other problems that may cause injury or ill health to other dogs
  - If they are a danger to the safety of any person or animal BFA Rule 5.18
- 9. It is the Team Captain's responsibility to ensure the team is available for their division and running order to help with the smooth running of the tournament.
- 10. No alcohol within the racing ring or around the competition arena.
- 11. No rubbish to be left on the site, Team Captains please make sure all your members clear up rubbish and dog poo to collection point.
- 12. If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
- 13. In the event of unforeseen circumstances the organisers reserve the right to make any alterations to the programme order they see necessary.
- 14. We need to make you aware that there may be other dog events at the Ibstock Show at the same time as our competition.
- 15. This is also a working farm and your co-operation and respect for the environment and boundaries would be very much appreciated!
