Those attending daily will require a vehicle pass to park in the designated flyball parking area inside the show ground. The day parking pass is £6 per vehicle and is to be paid with your flyball competition entry.

Please note: All vehicles using the flyball day parking and camping areas, must arrive within their designated areas by 9.30am and no vehicles will be able to leave the showground until 6pm (or until the show is closed to the public). Anyone wishing to arrive later or leave earlier must park in the free public car park outside the showground.

Show rules and regulations

1. The event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entry and admission to the event of any person not in good standing with the BFA.
2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh treatment of a dog whilst at the event.
3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area.
4. Mating of dogs is not allowed at a sanctioned BFA event
5. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - A) Suffering from an infectious or contagious disease
 - B) A danger to the safety of any person or animal
 - C) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
6. It is the team captain's responsibility to ensure that the team is available for their class, running order and ring party duties on time.
7. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
8. All owners and handlers enter their dogs at their and their pets own risk and whilst every care will be taken the event organiser(s) will not accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss, however caused to dogs persons or property whilst at the event.
9. All dog owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs, anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
10. BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament
11. All teams entering the show are expected to assist with ring party duties as required by the event organiser(s).
12. As the tournament is held within a public access area, there will be controlled movement of vehicles during the event. These movement restrictions will be announced on the running order to follow.
13. Anyone wishing to move their vehicles during the event will be required to park in the public car park, space permitting.
