Your entry will be confirmed and bank details e-mailed to you for electronic payment (payment must be received by closing date else your entry is void).

Show Details & Information

- The show will be run indoors, on rubber matting, laid on top of underlay and carpet on top of a deep layer of soil.
- Electronic timing and lights will be available in both the open and starters rings, with a 3 amber light start sequence (1s apart) as per the new rulings as of 1st January 2011.
- You will be unable to stake boxes down anywhere in the venue but we will supply heavy weights to place on the back of the boxes.
- We will be running 12 divisions of 5, giving each team 4 races.
- Each ring will be approx. 36' wide (and full length) with the lanes being set as wide as possible, though this may not be the maximum BFA distance.

Directions (postcode PE29 2NH)

From the North/West: Follow A14 to junc. 24. At the roundabout turn right (A1198).

From the South/East: Follow A14 to junc. 24. At the roundabout turn left (A1198).

Follow brown signs for Wood Green Animal Shelter and Flyball Signs. Wood Green is situated approx 1.5 mile from the roundabout. When you arrive, turn into Wood Green on the brow of the hill, and then follow flyball signs past public car park to 2nd car park beyond.

Show Rules and Regulations

- 1. The event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA
- 2. No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- 3. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs at the event is not allowed.
- 5. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - a. Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases.
 - b. A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
 - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- 6. It is the team captains responsibility to ensure the team is available for their class and running order.
- 7. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the Tournament, the organisers reserve
 the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees
 received.
- All dogs/owners/handlers enter the event at their own risk, and whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 10. All owners/handlers MUST clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 11. Current BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
