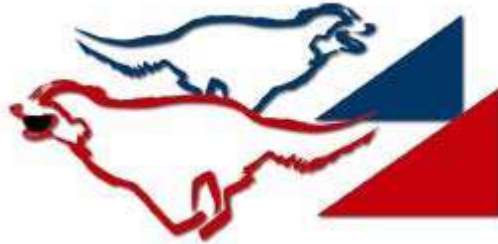

Show Rules and Regulations

1. The tournament organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any person not in good standing with the B.F.A.
2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament.
3. It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for its class and running order.
4. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
5. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
6. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - a. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease
 - b. A danger to safety of any person or animal
 - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
7. All dogs enter into the tournament at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
8. **All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.**
9. B.F.A. rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
10. No alcohol is to be consumed within or around the ring.
11. **NO BARBEQUES TO BE USED DIRECTLY ON THE GRASS**
12. Starters will be run based on current BFA rules. Jump heights and assistance at the box are left to the discretion of individual teams, based on the ability of their team. **Any Non BFA Members competing in Starters are the responsibility of the Primary Team Captain.**

Directions

Please note: postcode AB15 8SA is the nearest adjacent postcode (nearby farm), not the exact field location.

From South A90

Once over the Bridge of Dee, continue along the A90 / South Anderson Drive. Go through 3 roundabouts staying on A90 / South Anderson Drive.

At fourth roundabout, take first exit to B9119 / Queen's Road.

Continue on B9119 / Queen's Road – go through one roundabout.

Continue onto Skene Road.

At the roundabout take the first exit onto the A944.

At the 'Kingswells' roundabout, take third exit towards Kingswells.

Go straight on through traffic lights.

The turn for the event field is the second turn on the left after the lights. There is a sign for Denburn Stables and Granite City DAC at the turning. You will see the event field from the road.
