Show Rules and Regulations

- The tournament organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any person not in good standing with the B.F.A.
- 2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament.
- 3. It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for its class and running order.
- 4. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 5. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 6. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - a. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease
 - b. A danger to safety of any person or animal
 - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
- 7. All dogs enter into the tournament at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 8. All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 9. B.F.A. rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
- 10. No alcohol is to be consumed within or around the ring.
- 11. Starters, if held, will be run based on current BFA rules. Jump heights and assistance at the box are left to the discretion of individual teams, based on the ability of their team. Any Non BFA Members competing in Starters are the responsibility of the Primary Team Captain. If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
- 12. On and around the flyball field a strict speed limit (10 mph) will apply and vehicle movement restrictions will apply throughout the event.
- 13. Please be aware of our neighbours and keep noise to a minimum particularly between the hours of 11pm and 8am.

Directions

Please do not rely on Sat Nav's they take you to the wrong address!!

From Junction 16 of the M6

At roundabout take A500, signposted Crewe and Nantwich. Stay on the A500 following signs to Nantwich/Chester through 3 more roundabouts (2nd exit at the first; 1st exit at the second; 2nd exit at the third)

At next roundabout take 3rd exit A51 signposted Chester/Wrexham. Stay on the A51 following signs for Chester/Wrexham for 3 more roundabouts (2nd exit at each)

At Burford Crossroads go straight over at traffic lights, signposted A534 Wrexham

At T junction turn right to stay on the A534 towards Wrexham – go through Burland Village

Follow road past Thatch Pub on the right and take left turn into Woodhey Hall Lane

Take first left following road to Cooks Pit Pond and follow road to the right.

Follow road to T junction – entry to venue directly opposite junction.
