From Junction 16 of the M6

At roundabout take A500 signposted Crewe and Nantwich

At next roundabout take second exit A500 signposted Nantwich

At next roundabout take 1st exit A500 signposted Nantwich/Chester

At next roundabout take 2nd exit A500 signposted Nantwich/Chester

At next roundabout take 3rd exit A51 signposted Chester/Wrexham

At next roundabout take 2nd exit A51 signposted Chester/Wrexham

At next roundabout take 2nd exit A51 signposted Chester/Wrexham

At next roundabout take 2nd exit A51 signposted Chester/Wrexham

At Burford Crossroads go straight over at traffic lights signposted A534 Wrexham

At T junction go right A534 Wrexham – go through Burland Village

Follow road past Thatch Pub on the right and take left turn into Woodhey Hall Lane

Take first left following road to Cooks Pit Pond and follow road to the right.

Follow road to T junction – entry to venue directly opposite junction.

Show Rules and Regulations:

- (1) The Event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
- (2) No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- (3) Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- (4) A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is :
 - (a) Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases.
 - (b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
 - (c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- (5) It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for their class and running order.
- (6) No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- (7) The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- (8) All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Event Organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- (9) No alcohol can be consumed within or around the ring.
- (10) All owners/handlers must clean up after their dog. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- (11) If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
- (12) On and around the flyball field a strict speed limit (10 mph) will apply and vehicle movement restrictions will apply throughout the event.
- (13) Current BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.
- (14) Please be aware of our neighbours and keep noise to a minimum particularly between the hours of 11pm and 8am.

Information:

- (1) Applications for the Starters Event must be made at the same time as the Open Competition. Entries will be taken in the order received.
- (2) Camping is available onsite as are refreshments during the day.
- (3) Weather and time permitting, we will be running a Singles/ Pairs on Saturday and Sunday. All proceeds from this event will go to a local charity.
- (4) For local amenities and dog walking please ask at the admin tent. To book a table at the local pub 'The Thatch' please call – 01270 524223.
- (5) Saturday night meal tickets can be purchased at the weekend or on the entry form. Everyone is welcome to join us for the entertainment and we hope many of our neighbours will be joining us so that we can say thank you to them. Menu is attached.
