Also we are allowed to use the Leisure Centre common room at the bottom of the hill, useful particularly if the weather is inclement. This has bar facilities, times to be obtained.

There is a café on the Mount, open usually until 4 or 5pm. They will open evenings if sufficient meals are booked in advance. Please would team captains provide numbers of those interested and evenings required.

A food van will be available both weekends.

Show rules and regulations

N.B Team Captains/ Managers are responsible for ensuring that all members of their teams and accompanying party are informed of the rules and regulations pertaining to this tournament.

1. The flyball event organiser reserves the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of (a).any person not in good standing with the BFA. or (b). any person not complying with the request of the parking stewards.
2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs at the event is not allowed.
4. A dog must be withdrawn from the competition if it is:-
 - a. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease.
 - b. A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
 - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
5. It is the team captain's responsibility to ensure that the team is available on time for its class and running order.
6. No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
7. The organiser reserves the right to make any alterations deemed necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
8. All dogs are entered in this event at their owners risk and, whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
9. If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the tournament, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.
10. **All owners/handlers must clear up** after their dogs anywhere in the grounds. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
11. **All dogs are to be kept on a lead in or near the racing area when not actually racing.**
12. Current BFA Rules and Policies will apply in the racing area, throughout the Tournament.
