Information

The Dog House is a purpose-built canine training arena that regularly holds obedience and agility events and flyball training. **However, please note that Flyball lanes will have a maximum run back of 40 ft.** Please visit their web site for further details - www.doghousenortheast.co.uk. Food will be available at the venue at reasonable prices, a menu will be published nearer the time.

Directions From the South:

Head North on the A19. Leave A19 at next junction after Easington Services onto B1285 Dalton Park. At roundabout take 1st exit onto B1285. At next roundabout take 3rd exit onto B1285. Crossing back over the A19 take 1st right onto B1432. Turn right onto industrial estate signposted Doghouse/Flyball and follow additional Flyball signs to venue.

Directions From the North:

Head south on the A19. Leave A19 signposted A182 Dalton Park. At roundabout take 3rd exit onto the A182 then cross back over the A19. At the next roundabout take 1st exit onto B1285 Dalton Park. At next roundabout take 3rd exit onto B1285. Crossing back over the A19 take 1st right onto B1432. Turn right onto industrial estate signposted Doghouse/Flyball and follow additional Flyball signs to venue.

Show Rules and Regulations

- The Tournaments organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any person not in good standing with the BFA.
- No persons shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament.
- 3 It is the Team Captain's responsibility to ensure the Team is available for its class and running order.
- The organisers(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances arising.
- 5 Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 6 A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - a. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease
 - b. A danger to the safety of any person or animal
 - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
- All dogs enter into the tournament at their own risk, and whilst every care will be taken, the organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 8 All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 9 BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
- No alcohol is to be consumed within or around the ring.
- If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
