## **Show Rules and Regulations**

- 1. The events organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing with the B.F.A.
- 2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- 3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 4. A dog must be withdrawn form competition if it is:
  - a. Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases.
  - b. A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
  - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- 5. It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the team is available in their class and running order.
- 6. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances
- 7. All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to a dog's, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 8. All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 9. B.F.A. rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
