Show Rules and Regulations

- (1) The Event Organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
- (2) No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- (3) Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- (4) A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - (a) Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases or has suffered a contagious disease in the previous 21 days.
 - (b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
 - (c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- **(5)** It is the Teams Captain's responsibility to ensure the team is available for their division and running order.
- **(6)** The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- (7) All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Event Organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- (8) All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- (9) BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament
- (10) In the event of a 3 way tie winner will be decided on fastest times. In a 2 way tie the winner is who beat who.
