Declared times MUST be submitted by the Tournament Organiser at least 14 days prior to the Tournament, If a declared time is not submitted then the last available recorded time will be used (even if this is over 4 months old), if there are no previous times recorded for a team then a time of 22.00 seconds will be used as a declared time. A declared time may be submitted - it must be at least $\frac{1}{2}$ second faster or $\frac{1}{2}$ second slower than the Team's seeded time and will be subject to the Team break-out rule. Teams not on the seed list must submit a time and will be subject to the break-out rule. The break-out rule does not apply in Division 1.

- Event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing with the BFA.

- It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the team is available in their division and running order.
- All dogs are entered in the event at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage injury or loss, however caused, to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so, will be asked to leave the venue.
- No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area.
- Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases.
 - A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
 - Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.

If circumstances make it necessary for a tournament to be cancelled, the organiser(s) reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.
